



The project : SLL – “Skills for life: literacy”

Since 1st September 2014, five European schools have been working together to implement the partnership ”Skills for Life: Literacy” (SLL). The partner schools are:

- High School ”Stefan Procopiu” (Vaslui, Romania)-coordinator
- Foreign Language School (Pleven, Bulgaria)-partner
- 5th General Senior High School of Aigaleo (Aigaleo, Greece)-partner
- Yildirim Beyazit Anadolu Lisesi (Bursa, Turkey)-partner
- ISISS Cicognini Rodari (Prato, Italy) – partner

The purpose of the project is to value the literacy potential as an instrument for the personal and cultural development through the consolidation of the key transversal skills needed for lifelong learning. Objectives of our partnership:

- developing pupils skills in literacy (reading, writing, speaking and listening) and the transversal key competences (critical thinking, attitude networking, communication and collaboration with others, communication and English language, learning to learn, initiative).
- reading capitalization strategies for developing literacy skills in students and encourage reading for pleasure among students.
- developing teachers' knowledge and skills in the design and organization of lessons, learning units and activities.
- promoting the exchange of innovative practices and experiences between European schools through the development of teaching materials based on strategies for reading, writing, speaking.

11 teachers of Liceo Rodari and the students of three classes 3E-4C- 3I have taken part for a two-year period in the activities of the partnership, researching, experimenting and assessing didactic strategies.
