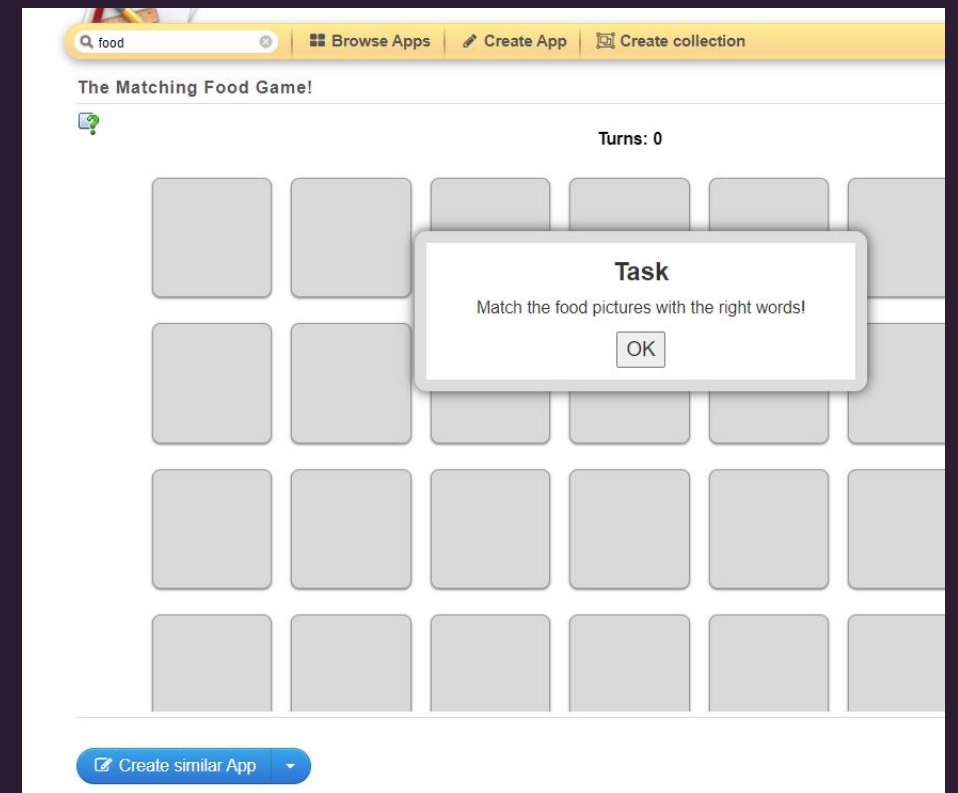
- Free

TASK 1 - CHANGE THE TEXT AND IMAGE

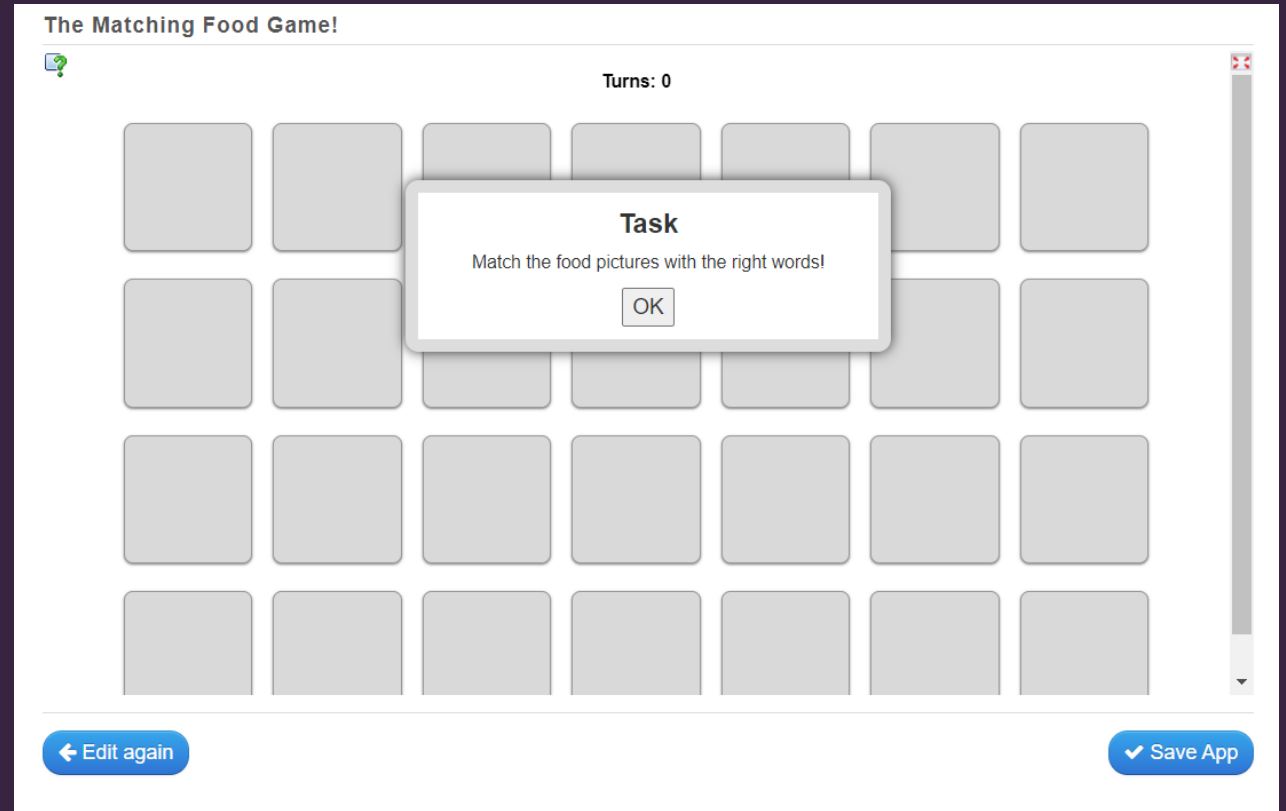
- Change the title



- Follow the steps (write the title, define the pairs (text+image))



- You can edit it anytime again




